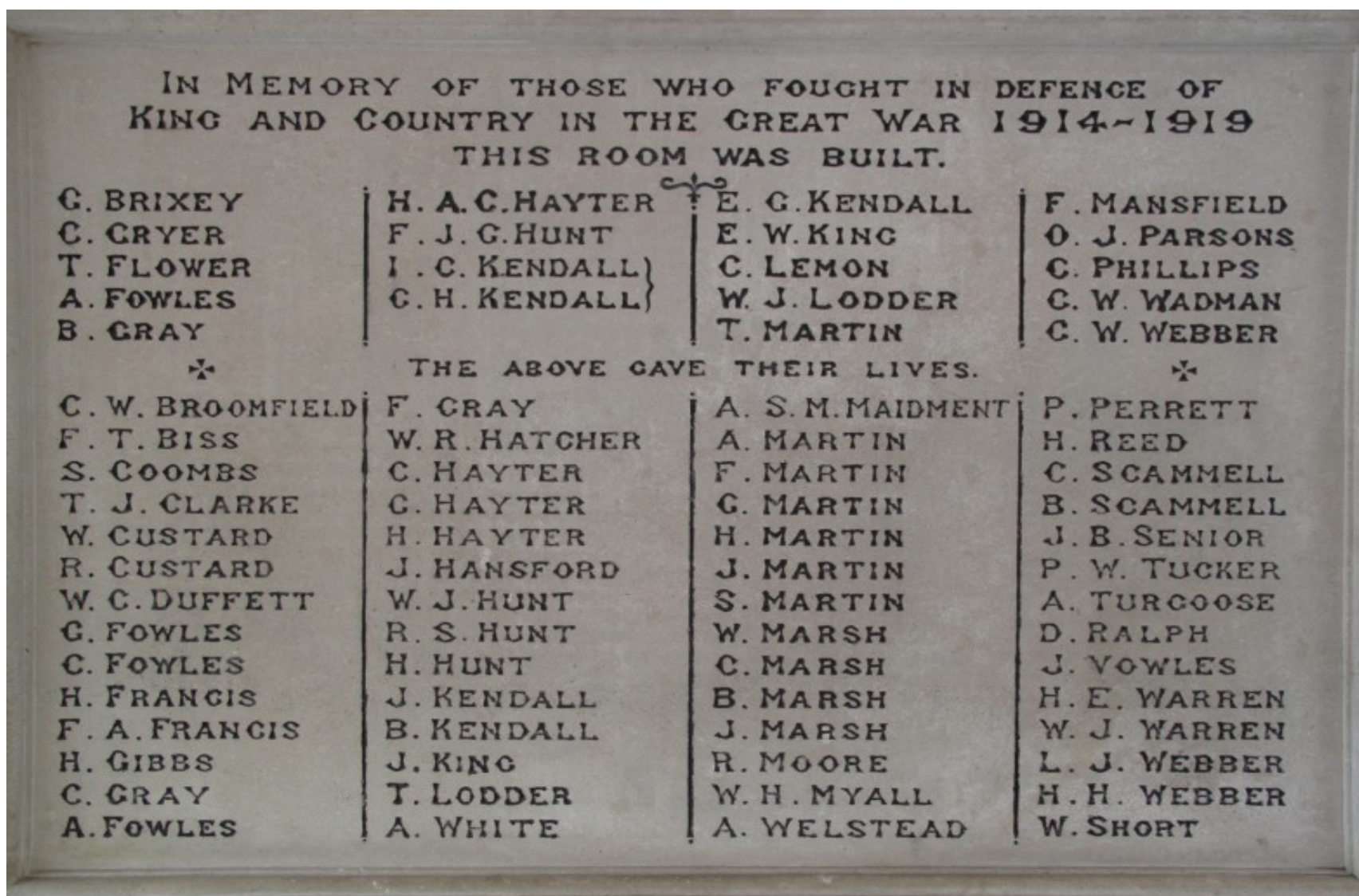

The Memorial Tablets of the Great War 1914-1919
and of the War 1939-1945 are fixed in the entrance hall
of the East Stour Village Hall.

Both are made of carved stone and are in reasonable condition.

Adjacent to the two tablets is a brass plate
measuring 15cm x 10cm inscribed:

**THESE TABLETS
WERE TRANSFERRED FROM
THE OLD PARISH HALL
SEPT 1973**
